

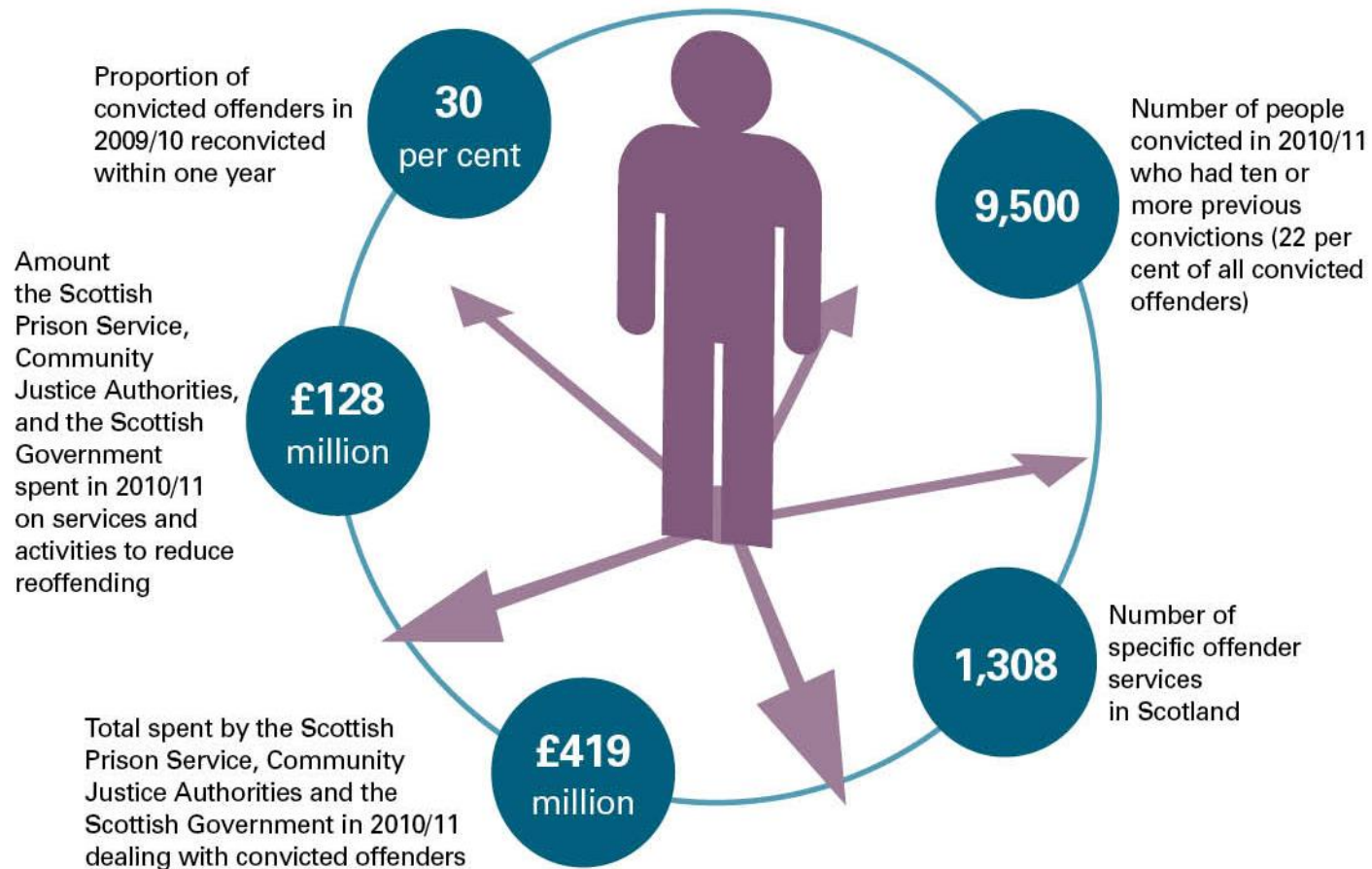

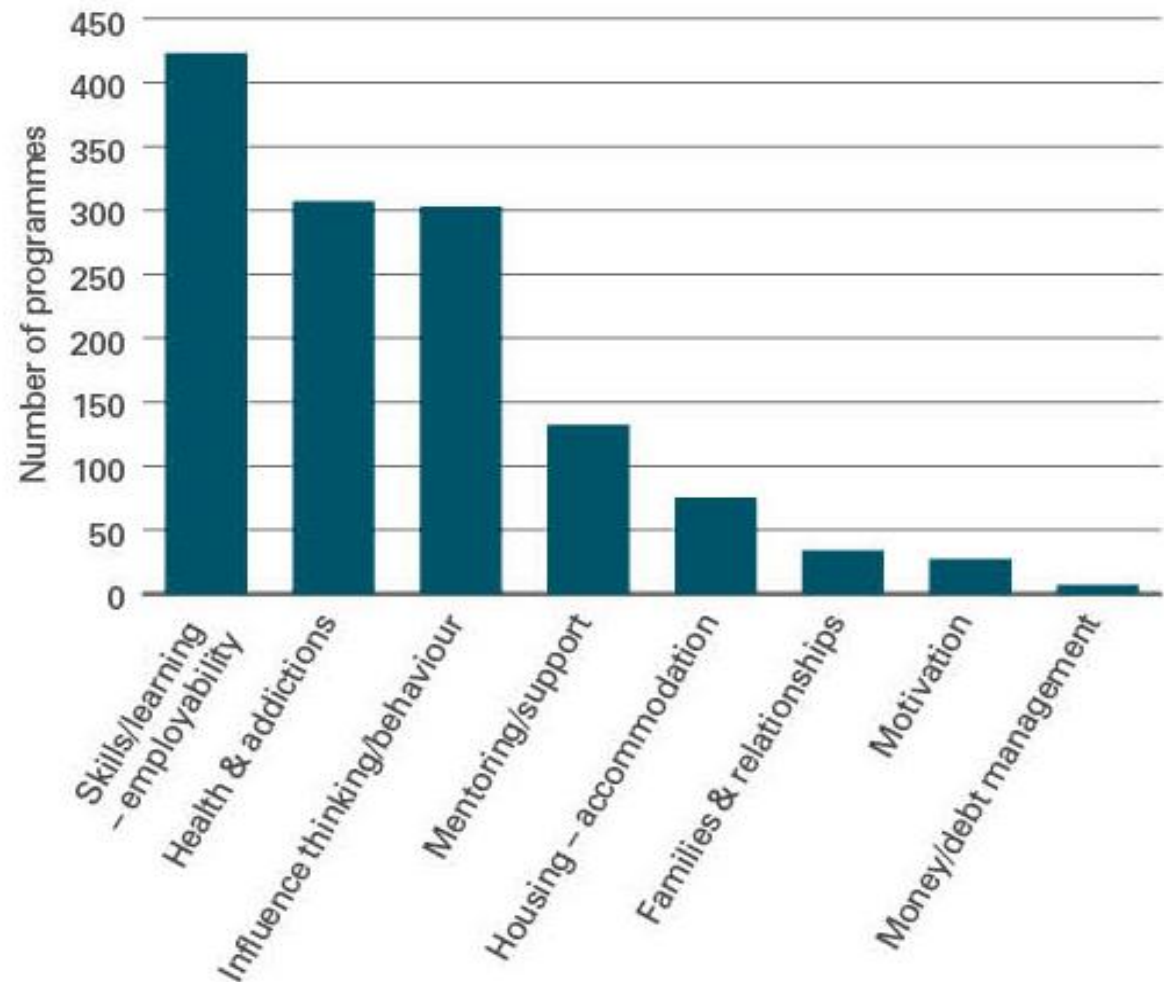


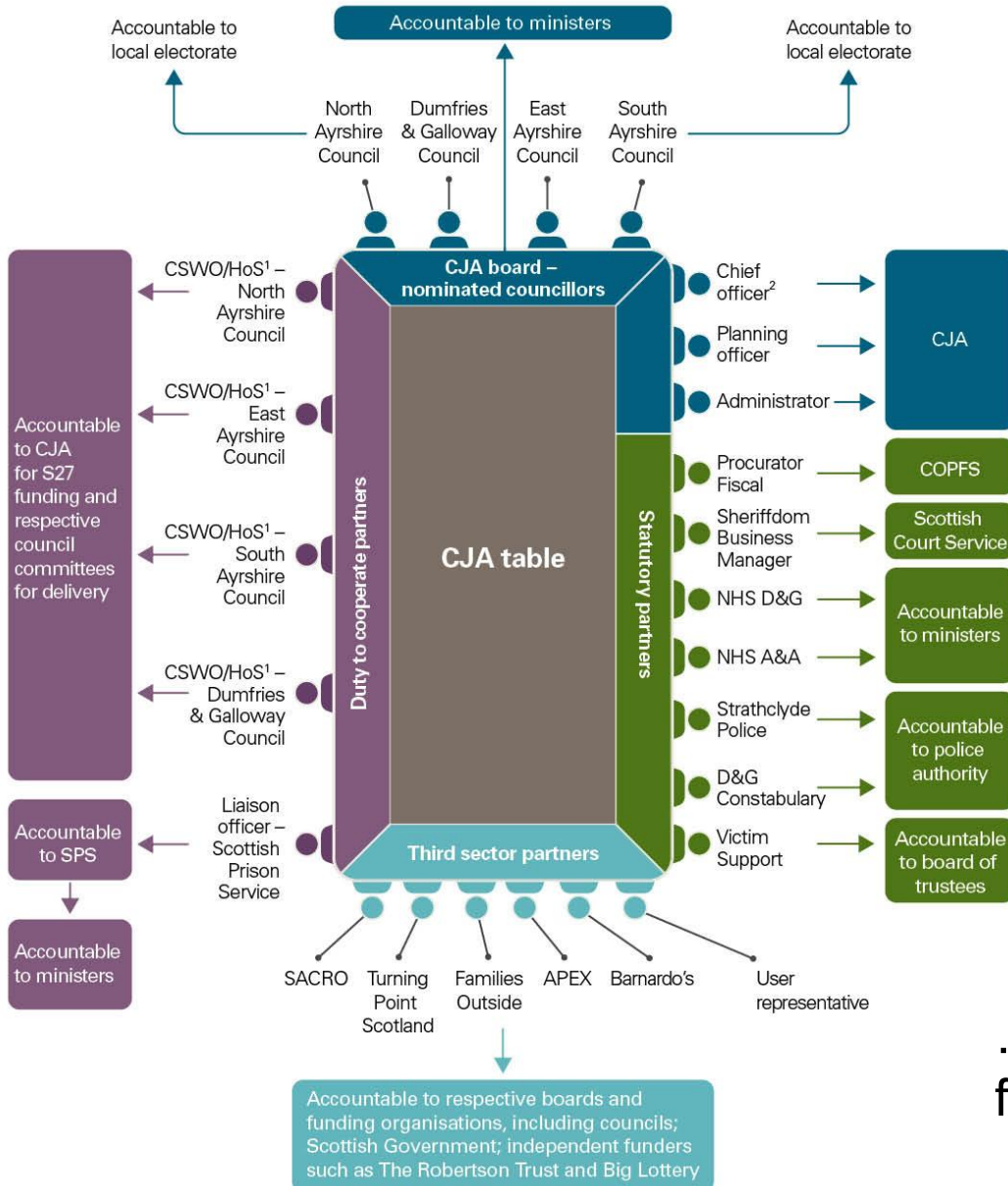
# Key facts

A complex landscape....

....with no clear accountability for reducing reoffending

- The Scottish Government should
  - improve funding arrangements for community justice
  - improve how performance is measured
  - review how offenders are managed in the community
  - and – working with CJAs, the Scottish Prison Service, other relevant bodies - improve how services for offenders are planned, designed, managed and delivered.
- CJAs and councils should improve their understanding of the unit costs of different criminal justice social work activities
